



ITINERARY:

DAY 1: Thursday September 26, 2024 Arrival

Arrival at Cagliari Elmas Airport and/or pick up from your hotel in Cagliari and transfer to your tour hotel in the vibrant capital of Sardegna. Enjoy the panoramic views of this capital city from the top of one of Cagliari's 7 hills and enjoy a breathtaking vista of this city. To accomodate all of the various arrival schedules, you are invited to settle in and refresh. Check in is available after 3pm and everyone is on their own to enjoy lunch (not included) at the hotel or to stroll along the city center or perhaps a dip at Poetto Beach. The entire group will meet in the lobby at 5pm for a panoramic aperitivo and pizza night.and Massimo and our Sardinian guide will brief you on your amazing trip ahead.

DAY 2: Friday September 27, 2024 Discovering Historic Cagliari, Capital of Sardegna

Today we explore Cagliari, the capital of Sardegna, founded in the neolithic age between 6000-3000 BC. But many centuries later, given its central position in the Mediterranean Sea, it was developed into a vital commercial port. And just like Rome and Lisbon, Cagliari is built upon 7 hills – so wear comfortable shoes!

Today we will combine walking and driving through Cagliari and region. We will explore the medieval walled quarter and the 13th Century Cathedral, and the historic hilltop Castle. Lunch will be in the city center where you will enjoy typical Sardinian flavours. In the afternoon, we will visit Pula and see one the most important Pheonician archaeological sites of Sardegna. Pack your suit, there's a great beach nearby! Then back to the hotel for free dinner in the hotel or in the city centre.




DAY 3: Saturday September 28, 2024 Il Sulcis-Iglesiente, The Mediterranean Sea & Mines

Today is an excursion day in the Sulcis-Iglesiente area with a return to Cagliari. We spend the morning discovering the industry that shaped Sardegna—mining--where we visit the world-famous 'Porto Flavia'. We will travel back a century through the mine which takes us all the way out to its famous door to the sea with an incredible vista.

Next, we transfer to an island in the Sulcis Archipelago and enjoy a lunch in 18th century town of Calasetta at a seaside restaurant on the island of Sant'Antioco. After lunch we will stroll this unique town and visit Sardegna's oldest church, Basilica di Sant'Antioco which features Sardegna's only catacombs. We won't leave this island without visiting Ipogeo Grotte Sant'Antioco, a village built into the stone dating from between the 6th and 8th century.

DAY 4: Sunday, September 29, 2024 La Marmilla and Mandrolisai

This morning we explore Sardegna's 1000-year historical site with a visit to the UNESCO site of Nuraghe Barumini, dating from the Bronze Age. There is nothing like this structure anywhere else in the world the ancient fortress at Barumini is known to be the finest and most complete example of this prehistoric architecture. Next, we head to the heart of Sardegna, and by many it is considered the "REAL" Sardegna where the most authentic traditions are kept still to this day. We are going into the center of this famous Barbagia Madrolisai area to explore the authentic gastronomy and "cultura santa" of the region. Dine with a local family at Casa di Nonna-- the same one that Zac Efron visited in his series, "Down to Earth" -- and experience pasta making and cooking over the wood fire. We will make the typical Sardinian bread, taste the local sheeps milk cheese and many other culinary traditions and sweets of this special "Blue Zone" region. The Barbagia region is one of 5 Blue Zones worldwide which boasts the largest number of centenarians. Hopefully we can learn a few tips!

DAY 5: Monday September 30, 2024 Il Mandrolisai & Su Gologone & Barbagia

Today our guide takes us to Tonara to visit with 3 generations-old artisanal "laboratorio di campanacci" dedicated to preserving this ancient Sardinian tradition. Next we transfer to Sorgono and visit the archeological park of Biru e Concas, the 'Sardinian Stonehenge'. After this visit back in time, we will enjoy a lunch in the vineyards at Cantina Fradiles. In the afternoon, we will transfer to the absolutely splendid Experience Hotel Su Gologone where you can relax, take in the vistas, the pool, and shop local treasures at its boutiques. We will meet in the evening and enjoy dinner at the hotel.

We dedicate this day to the Barbagian, pastoral way of life and will enjoy a typical Sardinian light lunch outdoors. Next we will discover some of Sardegna's oldest traditions, including a tasting of the famous Canonnau wine. We then make our way back to the exquisite hotel to relax after our hike. Dinner later in the evening at the Hotel Su Gologone.

DAY 7: Wednesday, October 2, 2024 Western Coast of Sardegna, It's oldest borough, Bosa, and the port town of Alghero



This is one of the oldest boroughs and authentic towns in all of Sardegna, and truly you will feel how time has stopped. We'll take advantage of this coastal town and enjoy an aperitivo at the Cantina della Malvasia and seafood lunch in Bosa. After lunch we make our way along more stunning coastline to the vibrant last stop of our tour: Alghero.

When we arrive in Alghero and after checking in to our hotel, we'll go for a stroll and aperitif at Villa Mosca. Your final evening is free to roam and enjoy this lively town, and you are free for dinner.
